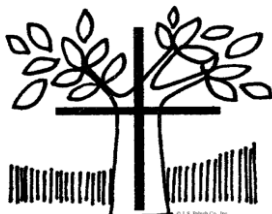

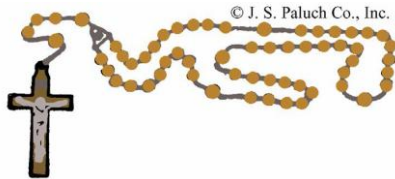


- meaning of the 'catechesis' (to echo)
