## SHEPHERDS LIKE JESUS

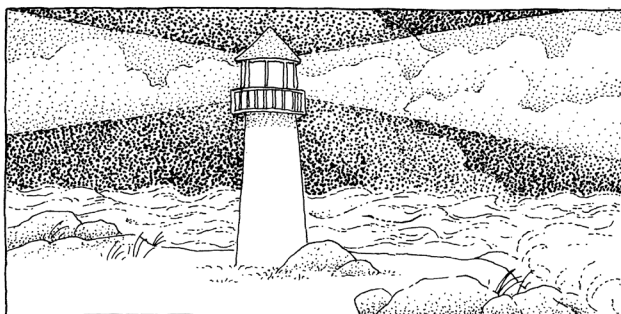
